# President's Message

## *Hometown Pride*

**I**t's been seven years since NASPD had a meeting in St. Louis. That's far too long. Your friends in the steel industry who live here can't wait to show off the wonderful things that are happening in our area. Here are just a few of the things that have happened since NASPD was last here:

- Downtown is revitalized with the building of a domed stadium (for the new Superbowl champion football team), convention center and hockey arena.

- A new baseball stadium is under construction.
- Add on the Washington Ave. and loft district, and you have the making of an energetic and vibrant downtown filled with young people.

NASPD will hold a reception on Friday evening, June 11, at the Missouri History Museum in Forest Park. Forest Park, site of the 1904 World's Fair, covers 1,380 acres and features the St. Louis Art Museum, the St. Louis Zoo, the St. Louis Science Center and the Muny Opera (the country's largest outdoor

theater). Through the efforts of local citizens, including NASPD's Joe Bergfeld, as well as state and federal efforts, Forest Park is enjoying a \$125 million renovation, which includes two 18-hole golf courses and six miles of biking and jogging trails. Some features from the 1904 World's Fair are getting a facelift including the Boat House, the Grand Basin, the Birdcage and the Jewel Box, a glass-covered Art Deco floral conservatory. We can't

wait for you to see the renaissance going on in this city.

The Missouri History Museum features the national touring Lewis & Clark exhibit. This year marks the 200th anniversary of the expedition, which started in St. Louis following the Louisiana Purchase. The Museum also houses a 1904 World's Fair exhibit and a replica of Charles Lindbergh's "Spirit of St. Louis." You'll also have an opportunity to take a carriage ride tour of the third largest city park in the US.

I would be remiss if I didn't mention the Gateway Arch National Monument and the Old Courthouse (site of the Dred Scott decision), located a few blocks from our hotel, the Westin St. Louis. On Saturday we'll tour the Anheuser Busch brewery, where you can sample the product.

A number of informative programs are planned for the Summer Conference. Mike Evans, of Maurice Pincoffs, will tell us "What's Next in the Steel Pipe Industry." Robert Johns, Director of Marketing for Nucor's Sheet Metal Group, will talk on "Steel: Not a Crisis, A Wake-Up Call." This is a chance for a real update on the steel market. On my recommendation, Shane Frank, managing Director of AlliantGroup, will speak on "R&D Tax Credits," which involves tax changes on research and development that may be available to some companies. If you qualify, the tax savings to your company may be significant.

As we have all experienced over the past several months the market is incredibly volatile. There is no better place than NASPD to get the most reliable information on the market. Now is the time to use our organization to stay informed and one step ahead.

In writing this article, it made me remember why I decided to raise my family here. It is easy to overlook all the great things your own city is accomplishing right before your eyes. I am glad to call St. Louis home. Please come and enjoy our hospitality. "Meet Me in St Louis" June 10 -12.

## PIPE-CORRODING BUG DECODED

Scientists with The Institute for Genomic Research (TIGR) in Rockville, MD have sequenced the genome of a sulfate-breathing bacterium that can damage oil and natural gas pipelines and corrode oilfield equipment.

The microbe, *Desulfovibrio vulgaris*, plays a role in a process called microbially-influenced corrosion (MIC), which has caused substantial economic losses in the petroleum industry and other industrial sites around the world. Such corrosion is caused by bacteria acting together in a biofilm that covers metal pipelines or equipment.

The analysis of the microbe's genes is expected to help researchers find better ways to minimize such damage as well as to develop methods to use microbes to help remediate metallic pollutants such as uranium and chromium.

"This genome will be a valuable asset to the community of scientists around the world who are studying the sulfate-reducing bacteria and their role in corrosion," says John Heidelberg, the TIGR assistant investigator who led the sequencing project.

The study, published in the May issue of *Nature Biotechnology*, was supported by the Microbial Genome Program of the US Department of Energy's Office of Science.

# What are the prospects of a new NASPD insurance program?

*Same song,  
second verse . . .  
Be ready to get on the

**F**irst, a little history. I met with the NASPD in the Spring of 1996 in Boston. Our give-and-take dialog led me to believe that the problem coverages were Worker's Compensation and Products

Liability. After contacting all of the NASPD Regular Members, and receiving turndowns from several potential insurance companies, we launched our NASPD Insurance Program in late May 1997 using Fireman's Fund as our insurer. Over the next two years, we contacted everyone again, quoted 32 accounts (some twice unsuccessfully), and wrote 16. But, because of some losses and our inability to write more of you quickly enough to satisfy the insurance company, they pulled the program in July 1999, offering renewals through October 1, 2000. There were a few other factors, such as our inability to interest the larger members, but you get the idea.

Beginning in March 2000, the Property/Casualty insurance business began to turn highly unprofitable: the stock market meltdown had begun in

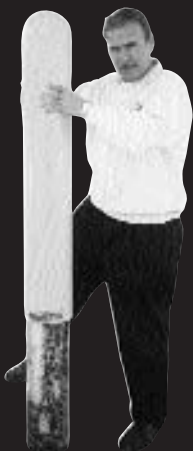
earnest, and 13 years of unwarranted competition (selling below cost) for premiums had "hardened" the underwriting appetite of virtually all insurers. They were running from business, and had no interest in taking on large "books" as would be a part of any program. So, for the past four years we have been renewing the accounts we originally wrote in eight to ten different insurance companies. We've lost a couple, added a few more, and now have a total of 17 NASPD members insured. The premiums have climbed because of the hard market, and because the sales and payrolls of our NASPD clients have grown as well.

**W**e have been working with a major North American insurer to try to put a new program together. Guess what? They're "worried" about the *Products Liability* and the *Worker's Compensation*—just like 8 years ago! The Carleton Unit at Crane Agency will get the job done. Tom Berra and I and our staff will scour the country until we find underwriters who eagerly embrace this opportunity! We have lots more ammunition this time—eight years premium and loss experience of a very representative sample of the entire membership.

What can you do to help us? Hang in there while we gather the boatloads of information that insurance people require, and be ready to get on the bandwagon when we announce the new program! There is strength in numbers, and the time to do this is now before the stock market soars again, and the underwriters start turning their profitable "books" of business "unprofitable" once more.

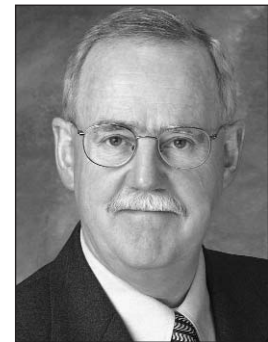
